To minimize these interruptions in chest compressions, the 2005 AHA Guidelines for CPR and ECC recommend that rescuers resume CPR beginning with chest compressions immediately after a shock, without an intervening rhythm (or pulse) check. Vasopressors or antiarrhythmics should be administered during CPR, as soon as possible after a rhythm check.
