A table of contents (TOC) is made up of entries. Each entry comes from a heading within your document, whether that's a report, a white paper, a dissertation, or something else. We can use the Styles pane in MS Word's Home tab to "tag" each heading: Heading 1, Heading 2, etc. (Sample text shows what each style looks like.)
