Guidelines to the writing of case studies

The significant cells in the field (whether they are red cells, white cells, and/or platelets) are always from the patient described in the case study.

The most important part of the clinical case question is the last sentence. This is the sentence that actually poses the question. Until this point, you cannot be sure exactly what you will be asked. Many students are tempted to simply skip to this last line, and then skim the case looking for necessary information to formulate an answer.
