If you use the rotation tool to rotate the object at any point along the path, while orient to path is on, the tween is recalculated to use that new orientation over the entire tween—meaning that Flash maintains that new rotation in relation to the path for the rest of the tween.

The biggest change between the old and the new method is that motion tween is now object-based rather than timeline-based as in the old method.

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
