A Six-Step Guide to Parking Lot Design

Parking Stall Layout Considerations . The objective of the layout design is to maximize the number of stalls, while following the guidelines below. The layout of the parking facility must be flexible enough to adapt to future changes in vehicle dimensions.

Parking Stall Layout Considerations - University of Idaho

The parking lot design objective is to maximize the total number of parking spaces in the space available with the following considerations: The parking layout should provide continuous flow of traffic through the lot. The design should allow safe movement of pedestrians from parking to buildings.

Parking Lot Layout Drives that do not allow parking within th e driveway right-of-way are normally 24' for two-way traffic and 12' for one-way traffic. For drives serving thirty (30) or fewer vehicles and where parking is not provided on either side, the width for two-way drives can be reduced to twenty-two (22) feet.

X02.6.1 On-street parking. X02.6.1.1 Minimum number required. (A) Accessible spaces. Where on-street public convenience parking is provided in commercial districts and at civic facilities, accessible on-street parking spaces shall be included in the total provided in the project or project area in accordance with proposed ADAAG Section 208.2 and shall be dispersed within the project area.

X02.6 Vehicular Ways and Facilities - United States Access ...

Recommendation: Where spaces within the same parking facility are assigned or restricted to specific user groups, consider calculating the minimum number of spaces separately for each type of parking or proportionately dispersing accessible spaces based on the overall total across each type of parking to ensure sufficient access for all users. Note that greater dispersion may be required under ...

Chapter 5: Parking Spaces - United States Access Board

The information contained in this chapter will provide a general guide to proper parking area design, construction, and facility layout. Minimum pavement thickness designs are given for both small parking areas (50 passenger car stalls or less) and larger facilities (over 50 passenger car stalls).

» Parking Lot Design - vaasphalt

The factors to consider in a parking lot layout include: parking lot size, pavement, parking space angles in consideration to level of vehicle turnover, accessibility requirements (ex. ramps), lighting design, landscaping, drainage, and overall traffic flow including that of pedestrians.
