In September 1791, Wollstonecraft began *A Vindication of the Rights of Woman: with Strictures on Political and Moral Subjects*, which elaborated a number of points made in the previous *Vindication*, namely, that in most cases, marriage was nothing but a property relation, and that the education women received ensured that they could not meet the expectations society had of them and almost certainly guaranteed them an unhappy life.

In "*Vindication*," though, she frames this responsibility as a primary role for women, distinct from men. Wollstonecraft went on to argue that educating women would strengthen the marital relationship. A stable marriage, she believed, is a partnership between a husband and a wife.
